Green Card Policy

Each plot holder will meet with their Garden Manager at the beginning of the season to pick a task for the season. **Green Cards will not be issued for projects or tasks not agreed upon in advance of the gardening season.**

The task can be a recurring duty, or a one-time project. The task should be tailored to the abilities and interests of the individual, and should benefit the garden and gardeners there as a whole. This is at the discretion of the GM or HGM (Head Garden Manager).

Upon reaching an agreement, the GM and the plot holder shall complete a Green Card, which the plot holder shall sign. The GM shall retain the Green Card until the task is completed. Upon completion, the GM shall sign the Green Card and return it to the gardener.

The gardener shall submit their Green Card with their Gardener Agreement form the following year to guarantee that they receive their former plot. Additionally, Green Card holders will be given priority if they request a different plot, or a plot in a different garden. **Gardeners without Green Cards will not be guaranteed the same plot they had the previous year and may be assigned a different plot.**
