1. Garden Managers---an opportunity to work as a team to organize and manage a community garden!

Includes signing up gardeners, building community in the garden, organizing volunteer tasks for gardeners, and addressing general garden needs. Current needs are comanagers at Bausch Park, Janet St. Park, and Selma Held Park

<u>Commitment</u>--Approx. 1 to 5 hours/week from April through October, plus 1 Garden Manager meeting per month from February through November

2. General Volunteer for various projects and events

These needs could include helping with garden maintenance projects or overseeing volunteer group projects, like spreading wood chips, harvesting produce for Helena Food Share, weeding, etc. Occasionally we need help with equipment and bed maintenance/repair.

HCG also hosts many fundraising events and welcomes help executing these events

Helena Food Share garden (a partner organization for HCG) also needs volunteers for weeding, watering, and harvesting produce, and working with new Farm Stand

<u>Commitment</u>-varies, usually a few hours depending on group/project/event, and can be one time or ongoing

3. Committee members

Commitment--Usually one meeting per month, plus a few hours of work on tasks
